

ESG Risk Rating Distribution




Although Verbund's generation activities have a low carbon footprint due to its low reliance on natural gas and coal, the electricity transport has a high carbon footprint due to grid losses and the usage of SF6, a gas with a huge impact on climate change. This exposes Verbund to risks associated with more stringent regulations aimed at mitigating climate change. Moreover, the development of hydro and wind installations could have significant negative impacts on local communities in their proximity because of water and land usage. This may trigger operational disruptions, project delays or shutdowns due to conflicts with residents. In addition, Verbund's employees are exposed to health and safety risks given the dangerous nature of operations with high voltage lines or at high-altitude. Too frequent incidents or fatallities could trigger operational disruptions and lawsuits.

The company's overall exposure is high and is moderately below subindustry average. Occupational Health and Safety, Carbon - Own Operations and Community Relations are notable material ESG issues.



Verbund's overall ESG-related disclosure follows best practice, signalling strong accountability to investors and the public. The company's ESG-related issues are overseen by the board or the executive team, suggesting that these are integrated in core business strateov.
